FS 1 EVENTS

- FS 1.1 There will be four Events. Senior Men, Senior Women, Youth Men and Youth Women.
- FS 1.2 Division A (Senior Men) and Division B (Senior Women) shall start separately but will sail on the same Senior course area.
- FS 1.3 Division C (Youth) Men and Women shall start separately but will sail on the same Youth course area.

FS 2 FORMAT - GENERAL

- FS 2.1 Each event will consist of an Opening series followed by Finals.
- FS 2.2 The schedule will be set irrespective of planning conditions.

FS 3 FORMAT - OPENING SERIES

- FS 3.1 12 (twelve) Opening series races are scheduled over 4 (5 in case Reserve Day is used) days followed by 1 (one) Opening Series race on the last day for boards that do not qualify for the Finals.
- FS 3.2 If an Event is split into fleets, the Opening series will consist of a Qualifying series followed by a Advance (Gold/Silver) series.
- FS 3.3 The Opening Series is extended to include a Last Race for boards that do not qualify for the Finals. If split fleets are used, there will be a Last Race for each of the Gold and Silver fleets on the day of the Finals.

FS 4 FORMAT - FINALS

- FS 4.1 Three Final races are scheduled on the last day
- FS 4.1.1 A one race Quarter Final for the 12 highest ranked boards from the Opening Series.
- FS 4.1.2 A one race Semi Final for the 6 highest ranked boards from the Quarter Final.
- FS 4.1.3 A one race Grand Final for the 3 highest ranked boards from the Semi Final.

FS 5 SCORING - OPENING SERIES

- FS 5.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A and Appendix B8 shall apply to Opening series.
- FS 5.2 Minimum Number of Races
- FS 5.2.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a valid Championship.
- FS 5.2.2 Six races are required in the Opening Series before the Finals will be sailed.
- FS 5.2.3 If an Event is divided into split fleets, 4 races are required in the Qualifying series and 2 races are required in the Advance (Gold/Silver) series.

- FS 5.3 The overall results for the 2017 RS:X Windsurfing European Open Trophy will be published as 'Open Trophy' results and overall results for the 2017 RS:X Windsurfing Youth European Open Trophy will be published as 'Youth Open Trophy' results
- FS 5.4 Scores for the 2017 RS:X Windsurfing European Championships and the 2017 Marseille RS:X U21 Windsurfing Championships will be extracted from the overall 'Open Trophy' results without recalculation.
- FS 5.5 Scores for the 2017 RS:X Windsurfing Youth European Championships and the 2017 Marseille RS:X U17 Windsurfing Championships will be extracted from the overall 'Youth Open Trophy' results without recalculation.
- FS 5.6 Discards in Opening series
- 1-3 Races No score excluded
 - 4-10 Races Worst race score excluded
 - 11 + Races Two worst scores excluded. However, in split fleets the worst score in the Qualifying series and the worst score in the Advance (Gold/Silver) series shall be excluded.

FS 6 SCORING - FINALS

- FS 6.1 There will be no point scoring in the Finals. A board's score in a race will be based on her finishing order in that race.
- FS 6.2 The Final races shall not be excluded neither will the Final races trigger any discards from results in Opening Series.
- FS 6.3 The boards assigned to compete in the Finals will be ranked highest in the regatta except a board penalized under RRS 5, 6, 7 or 69 may be ranked differently.
- FS 6.4 The first 6 (six) finishers in the Quarter Final race shall advance to the Semi Final. Boards finished in places 7 to 12 shall be scored in those positions in the Event. If no Quarter Final is completed, boards will be ranked according to overall scores in Opening Series.
- FS 6.5 The first 3 (three) finishers in the Semi Final race shall advance to the Grand Final. Boards finished in places 4 to 6 shall be scored in those positions in the Event. If no Semi Final is completed, boards will be ranked according to their finishing positions in Quarter Final.
- FS 6.6 The winner of the Grand Final race is the winner of the Event. The second finisher shall be scored 2nd place and the third finisher shall be scored 3rd place in the Event. If no Grand Final is completed, boards will be ranked according to their finishing positions in Semi Final.
