Fact Found:
FRA 152 and JPN 54 were sailing on a downwind course on starboard tack overlapped. FRA 152 was to windward of JPN 54 at a distance of 3 board lengths and on converging courses. As FRA 152 was rounding the mark 3P FRA 152 was inside and JPN 54 was outside, the distance between the boards was 1,5 board lengths. A contact occurred between FRA 152 bow and the mark, FRA 152 was catapulted into the water. No penalty was taken.
