CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Delete the following sailing instructions and replace with:

- 2.1 RS:X Men: Competitors shall wear lycras of the same colour as the fleet in which they are racing that day (see SI 9 – Class Flags & Fleet Colours).

RS:X Women: Competitors shall wear orange lycras and carry a ribbon of the same colour as the fleet in which they are racing that day(see SI 9 – Class Flags & Fleet Colours). Ribbons shall be attached to the retaining strap of the second batten down from the head of the sail.

- 2.4 The lycras, ribbons and the discs will be supplied by the Organising Authority.
- 2.5 Lycra shall be worn outside other clothing while racing. Competitors may cut the lycra from the point where the seams meet under each arm a maximum of 10 cm along each seam. A small hole may be cut for the harness hook. No material shall be removed. No other deliberate cuts or tears are permitted. All advertising shall remain displayed as intended.
- 6.5 [DP] [NP] On the last day of racing and if Medal Races are scheduled, boards shall not launch until the display of:

<i>Race</i>	<i>Signal</i>
Men's Medal Race	Flag M over Men's Gold Fleet Class Flag
Women's Medal Race	Flag M over Women's Gold Fleet Class Flag
Final Fleet Race	Flag D alone

- 8.9 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1200. A coach briefing is scheduled on each racing day, to be held at 1000 in front of the race office.
- 9.1 The class flags, lycras and ribbons will be as follows:

Men's Blue/Silver Fleet	Blue	N/A	Blue flag with RS:X logo

Women's Blue/Silver Fleet	Orange	Blue	Green flag

- 15.1 During the races, the Race Committee may shorten the course according to RRS 32. In addition, if Flag T is displayed (with multiple sound signals) at mark 3 on a Trapezoid Course or mark 4 on a Windward/Leeward Course, competitors shall, having sailed through the gate, proceed immediately to the finishing line, sailing through the slalom if one is present.
- 20.12 Competitors assigned to compete in the Medal Race will be ranked highest in the regatta. This may not apply to a boat disqualified under RRS 5, RRS 6 or RRS 69.
- 21.5 When flag F is displayed with repetitive sounds, coach and other support boats shall monitor the Race Committee UHF channel and assist in search and rescue operations.
- 26.2 Actions by official boats or helicopters shall not be grounds for requesting redress by a board. This changes RRS 60.1(b).
