Transfer the part of the RS:X Class funds to the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class

Purpose or Objective

Because the RS:X Class is no longer the Olympic class, the Class activity is reduced. Therefore, it is reasonable to transfer the part of the Class funds to the youth and junior windsurfing but specifically to the pre-Olympic class, i.e. to the iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class.

Proposal

To transfer 30,000 euros from the RS:X Class funds to the International iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Association.

The International iQFOiL Youth & Junior Class Association shall dedicate that fund to the Emergent Nations Program, to help emergent nations to start foil windsurfing.

Current Position

The International RS:X Windsurfing Class Association has about 60,000 euros on its accounts.

Reason

Because the RS:X Class is no longer the Olympic class, the activity of the Class will be reduced and there is no need for a large budget. (However, there are still Asian Games on 2022 which are using the RS:X equipment and the intention is to schedule the 2022 RS:X Windsurfing World Championships, to provide the opportunity for those countries and sailors who still have the equipment and willing to compete on it).

The International RS:X Class Association should firstly support the youth and junior windsurfing, i.e. the younger generation who are the future of Olympic windsurfing. To attract young people to start (foil) windsurfing and specially from the emergent countries.

As the new Olympic windsurfing (iQFOiL) has two separate classes, one for Youth & Junior fleet and another for seniors, i.e. the Olympic class, the support shall be given to the Youth & Junior class instead of Olympic class, which has much better opportunities to get their own additional funding (sponsors) than the Youth & Junior class.
